

Plastic Puddling Spot

This is a simple to make puddling spot for butterflies in your garden. Project cost: around \$3.00 depending on size.



Material Needed:

- * **Plastic plant saucer**, any size will work. Available from and garden center.
- * **Play sand**, enough to fill plant saucer. Available in and sand box.
- * **Tablespoon of Salt**. Table salt or seas salt will work. Check the pantry cupboard.
- * **Rocks**. A few rocks medium sized rocks. Available in the backyard.

Tools Needed:

- * **Tablespoon**

Step 1:

Fill the plastic plant saucer with enough play sand to bring the level up about 1/2 inch below the top rim of the saucer.



Step 2:

Mix 1 tablespoon of salt into the play sand making sure it is well mixed. This will provide nutrients to the butterflies. Smooth out the sand after.



Step 3:

Push the rocks half way into the sand to provide a place for the butterflies to perch on.

Step 4:

Place in a sunny spot in your butterfly garden.

Add more salt once every 3 months by sprinkling 1 teaspoon onto the sand.
